

COVID-19 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

- Masks are optional at this time for students and staff. (Updated July 1, 2021).
- Hand sanitizer is available for students and staff. It is recommended that all students wash their hands with soap before attending class and again once they return home.
- Classes with different groups of students are intentionally scheduled with time in between to allow for barres and equipment to be sanitized as well as limit number of students in the lobby at one time.
- Students should **not come to class** if they have a fever or any symptoms of COVID-19, including chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea. **Students who arrive to class and present with any of these symptoms will be sent home.**
- Students should not come to class until they have been symptom-free for 10 days if they have had known contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19, or if they have had a positive COVID-19 test result themselves.
- PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WAIT INSIDE THE STUDIO WHILE THEIR CHILD IS IN CLASS.

HOW TO ENTER + EXIT THE STUDIO: (Tiny Ballet & Primary levels)

- Students in Tiny Ballet and Primary level classes will line up outside the studio with a parent on the sidewalk in front of the classroom and wait to be welcomed in by a teacher. After class, parents will (again) line up **outside** the studio on the sidewalk and will be matched to their child at the door after class.
- **TINY BALLET ONLY:** Parents are permitted to be inside the studio for only the first two weeks of the semester to help their little one get acclimated. A “class parent” (one per week) will sit inside the studio and assist with potty breaks if needed. All other parents must wait outside the studio. **Because the class is only 30 minutes, we ask that parents remain on the premises for the duration of class.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Parents are welcome to view their child's class from the sidewalk outside the studio as there are large glass windows.
- Parents may park in the studio parking lot and wait in their cars or drop off and run errands.
- NO FOOD is to be consumed inside the studio.
- All studio classes have the option to Zoom into the live class should a student have a sick family member at home but the student themselves is healthy.
- If the studio closes due to government mandates, classes will continue on Zoom for the remainder of the semester or until the studio reopens. In this event, tuition will remain the same.
